2018 WRANGLER MEMBERSHIP

NEW: We have decided to update our Wrangler Classifications along with the CCMSA. With doing this we want to improve cohesiveness with the CMSA USA Wrangler points tracking system and to still abide by our differing Canadian Firearms Laws.

Our goal is to train and prepare our youth for full competition starting at age 18 here in Canada and age 12 in the USA

The following applies to practices, competition and demonstrations

- Any and all Wranglers must wear a Helmet at all times while on a horse.
- All wranglers must hold a AEF/SHF membership.
- Pylon cones may/will be placed to direct wranglers through courses.
- Peewee, Novice and Junior Wranglers will be briefed and walked through patterns on their horses prior to being timed.
- Parent must designate a guardian if they are absent for **EACH** shoot. The Wrangler must carry a letter with them like a PAL.
- The Range Master has the final say in all instances.
- No participant under 18 years of age shall fire **ANY** firearm while mounted at any practice, jackpot, clinic or competition.
- Wranglers may move up when deemed ready by the parent. However, the Range Master has final input on any and all safety at all shoots.
- No move backs so Wranglers are encouraged to practice!

Pee wee Wrangler- Any child under the age of 18 as of the day after CMSA World Championships Oct 15th 2016.

- requires being lead through the course and
- automatically will score **60 seconds** per run as per CMSA Rules and
- will **NOT** participate shooting on the ground.

Novice Wrangler- Any child under the age of 18 as of the day after CMSA World Championships Oct 15th 2016.

- will ride thru the course with no assistance
- engages targets as per the CMSA rulebook regarding Wranglers
- will **NOT** participate shooting on the ground
- have holsters and at least 1 cap gun is encourage
- scoring as per CMSA Wrangler rules

Junior Wrangler- Any child under the age of 18 as of the day after CMSA World Championships Oct 15th 2016

- will be briefed on the course and will participate in course walk through patterns on horse prior to being timed
- qualifies by a demonstration of skill
- is approved to shoot by the Range Master
- will be wearing all proper attire for competition including Helmet/hat, safety glasses, ear protection, chinks and holsters
- will shoot all balloons from the ground with TWO hands, with-in arms distance and in direct supervision of a shooter/Range Master with a valid Restricted PAL
- penalties are the same as adult counterparts, as per decision by Range Master
- scoring as per CMSA Wrangler rules

All wrangler points will be tracked for a Canadian title and separate from the CMSA.
